2023 Waiver and Release Form

The Berwyn Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Berwyn Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participant's safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program/activity must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities/programs. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

WARNING OF RISK: Recreational activities/programs are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity/program. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Depending on the particular activity, participants must understand that certain risks, dangers and injuries due to inclement weather, slipping, falling, poor skill level or conditioning, carelessness, horseplay, unsportsmanlike conduct, premises defects, inadequate or defective equipment, inadequate supervision, instruction or officiating, and all other circumstances inherent to indoor and outdoor recreational activities/programs exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Berwyn Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in this program/activity, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damage or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of participating in this program/activity against the Berwyn Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Berwyn Park District" I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Berwyn Park District from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this program/activity. I further allow the Berwyn Park District to use my likeness and photograph for promotional purposes. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND INDEMNIFICATION**

FOR USE OF INHALER OR AUTO-INJECTOR DEVICES

Please read this form carefully and be aware that pursuant to the Illinois Asthma Inhalers at Recreational Camps Act, 410 ILCS 607/1 *et seq.*, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain in connection with the possession, self-administration, or use of medication, including, but not limited to the use of an epinephrine auto-injector or inhaler at the camp or at any camp-sponsored activity, event, or program; except for claims arising out of the willful and wanton conduct of the Berwyn Park District.

As parent/guardian of the below identified participant, I verify and attest that my child/ward has the knowledge and skills to safely possess, self-administer, and use an epinephrine auto-injector or inhaler in a camp setting. I also recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants' possession, self-administration, or use of medication, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said possession, self-administration, or use of medication. Such risks include, but are not limited to, failing to properly administer the medication, failing to observe side effects, failing to assess and/or recognize an adverse reaction, failing to assess and/or recognize a medical emergency, and failing to recognize the need to summon emergency medical services.

I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of or arising out of the possession, self-administration, or use of medication against the Berwyn Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees; except for claims arising out of the willful and wanton conduct of the Berwyn Park District.

I further agree to protect, indemnify, save, defend and hold harmless the Berwyn Park District from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, penalties, causes of action, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) for which the Berwyn Park District may become obligated by reason of the possession, self-administration, or use of medication; except to the extent caused by the willful and wanton conduct of the Berwyn Park District.

Berwyn Park District Camp Summer Camp 2023 Behavior Guidelines

For all participants safety, the Berwyn Park District provides Behavior Guidelines for all programs. For our summer camp programs, children are given 3 warnings all summer. All are documented and the parent/guardian will be notified. In the event of the 3rd warning the Berwyn Park District reserves the right to remove the child from the program.

No refunds will be given. The Park District has made every effort to hire capable staff for our camp programs. Your cooperation as a parent is greatly appreciated; and your understanding allows the Berwyn Park District to better serve all youth. In order to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment, a strict discipline policy has been adopted. The following policies are designed to preserve a healthy program experience for all concerned.

The following infractions constitute utilization of the discipline system:

1. Harming one's self such as, but not limited to:
 - A. Leaving designed grounds without permission
 - B. Leaving designed group without permission
 - C. Physical damage to self
 - D. Showing disrespect to other participants and staff
2. Harming others such as, but not limited to:
 - A. Fighting, Hitting or kicking others
 - B. Throwing objects at or near others
 - D. Extreme verbal use
 - E. Profanity
 - F. Other aggressive behavior
3. Damage to property:
 - A. Vandalism, **NOTE:** Parent/Guardian of program participants is responsible for ANY damages caused by their child.
 - B. Tantrums resulting in damage to property
 - C. Breaking, damaging, or destroying property (Park District, camper or general public)
 - D. Theft: Taking any item that does not belong to the child or does not belong to them
4. Others
 - A. Possession, use or transfer of alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco or tobacco products (matches and lighters).
 - B. Any threat of bodily harm to others
 - C. Fighting with anybody
 - D. Bringing any weapons to camp
 - E. Any proven or confessed theft

Depending on the degree of the offense, a program participant may be permanently dismissed from the program following the 1st, 2nd or 3rd offense. **There will be NO REFUNDS for missed days due to disciplinary infractions.** Your signature indicates you have read the above material and understand it fully. Behavior Code of Conduct

In keeping with our program goals, we encourage fun for all of our participants. Certain rules are necessary to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment.

Behavior

Participants are expected to always exhibit appropriate behavior. The Berwyn Park District's behavior code:

Participants shall:

- Remain with the group (not run off by self).
- Show respect to all participants and staff.
- Refrain from using inappropriate language.
- Refrain from causing bodily harm to himself or others.
- Show respect to equipment, supplies, and facilities.
- Allows zero-tolerance for bullying.

Additional rules may be developed for specific programs, camps, and other programs as deemed necessary by the district.

Discipline

A caring, positive approach will be used regarding discipline. The Berwyn Park District staff will review rules and explain consequences at the beginning of camp. Each situation that arises will be evaluated on its own merit.

Procedure

If a participant exhibits inappropriate actions, the following general guidelines will be followed:

- Warning is given.
- Time away from the program (2 – 5 minutes).
- Report to full-time program supervisor.
- Parent contacted by supervisor if and when behavior continues.
- Plan formulated with parent to modify behavior or removal from program.
- No refunds will occur due to disruptive, aggressive, and intolerant behavior.

If a participant's behavior does not improve, the participant will be dismissed from the program (#6.) The Berwyn Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers the safety of himself or others. The Camp Supervisor will make final determination on dismissals. If a dismissal is made, refunds for unused sessions will not be granted.

Parent/Guardian understands the Behavior Code of Conduct above and has explained this to their child/children participating in the 2022 Summer Camp at the Berwyn Park District.
